

<u>Technical Rider & Stage Plan</u>

Thank you for your interest in Delphia. Below is a list of our technical requirements. We designed this rider for optimum effectiveness, but if there are any questions or if you have trouble providing any of the below mentioned please get in touch with us before the day of the show, preferably one week out. and we will work towards a solution.

Our stage setup is:

- 1 Drum kit
- 1 Bass Guitar
- 1 Electric Guitar
- 1 Saxophone
- 1 Keyboard
- 2 String Players (violin / viola)
- 1 Piano
- 1 Primary Vocal
- 2 Harmony Vocals (at saxophone and keyboard)
- 1 Presentation Vocal
- 1 Laptop Computer with 3 Line-Outs

Unless otherwise arranged, it is necessary for the presenter to have a well sized standard PA system provided for with sufficient power to supply a clean and undistorted 110dB SPL RMS to the mixing desk and a powerful and feedback-proof monitor system. It is very important that the singers (piano/presenter, keyboard, saxophone) and the drummer each have their own monitor speakers with separate mixes. Each additional performer needs to be equipped with a monitor speaker as well, although separate mixes are not imperative. For venues over 300 people we will need one additional monitor for the guitar player and saxophonist each and two side-fills for large venues over 1000 seats.

*****NOTE FOR SHOWCASE*****

In an effort to demonstrate our entire show as sold, we are providing a full rider as presented for our eight piece ensemble. Due to the time constraints and limitations of the Showcase format, the demonstration performance will be as a four or five piece ensemble. Known parts that will not be performing are stricken through-out to allow the judges to see what parts are missing.



Showcase Set Up

Eight performers in a minimal production designed to showcase the musical abilities of the performers, the songwriting skills of the featured artist, and the audience engagement of the featured artist's personal story of inspiration, trauma, recovery, and hope.





****NOTES FOR SHOWCASE****

Due to limitations and constraints on the showcase format, the string players and guitar player will not be part of our presentation.

Minimum Stage dimensions: 18' x 16'



****THE FOLLOWING MAY NOT BE APPLICABLE FOR THE SHOWCASE****

ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT

Two music stands and two chairs for the string players

Drum Riser and Floor Carpet (approx. 6ft x 4ft) for drums on the stage

Table for a laptop next to the keyboardist

Rear Projection System and video playback as lighting effects

STAFF

We will need a qualified sound engineer, stage technician and lights technician. Our manager can operate as sound engineer from stage out to house, but will still need on site staff to operate FOH sound system. We depend heavily on the staff on-site.

SOUND & LIGHTING

We prefer an overall natural sound with minimal processing and effects. The drums are to remain fairly dry, please use gates only when unavoidable and with great care. The vocals are best with light to medium plate and very light church reverberation, and only when singing. Her EQ is usually best at +2dB@325Hz, -3dB@700Hz, +3dB at 2.5KHz, +5dB@5.5KHz, and +3dB at 14KHz. During monologues, all reverberation and delay must be removed from the main vocalist. The harmonies can have more reverberation and delay to their voices, and overall, they should be quieter in the mix.

Lighting will be based on the availability of each space. Generally, there should be the ability to darken the stage, light the entire stage as well as individual musicians, and introduce different color palettes to the back screen, in addition to projecting video overlays via rear projection. Please do NOT use fog and do NOT use stroboscope effects ever.

EQUIPMENT SHARING & SOUNDCHECK

The drummer is amenable to sharing a backline drumkit, or bringing his own. The bass amp can be brought on, or provided for, but this needs to be discussed well before the show. We will need an absolute minimum of 45 minutes soundcheck, and two hours for load-in. A one day lead on load-in and soundcheck is preferable, but not mandatory.

ARRIVAL

Please provide detailed directions two weeks before the date of the show with the complete address of the venue and a telephone contact. We need a safe parking space available for the vehicle close to the venue. Please provide arrival, soundcheck and doors-open and on-stage times. The promoter or another person should be at the venue at arrival time.



FOOD & DRINKS

9 meals, no dietary restrictions, preferably healthier options, or eight stipends of \$12 each for buy-out minimum 24 bottles of cooled non-carbonated water for stage and backstage minimum 12 liters of other cooled other drinks (juice and soda is fine) 2 bottles of red wine is appreciated if venue permits Where applicable, breakfast for 9 persons the morning after the show.

BACKSTAGE

A separate room for the band to get some rest before and after the show. It would be great to have some sofas, tables, chairs, a mirror and sink.

SLEEP

A warm, clean, dark and quiet accommodation for 9 persons with mattresses, bath room, shower and mirror. A safe parking space near the sleeping accommodation should be available.

MERCHANDISE

A table of approx. 4 feet in length and a small light or some candles for our merchandising and to meet, greet, and sign memorabilia.

MISCELLANEOUS

A guest list of 10 persons.
